RE: DC board letter,

Water distribution main & service lines:

- * T&S completed the new temporary tank install at Cerrito and is currently connected to our main. The old redwood tank is currently off-line and will be taken down within the next couple of weeks.
 - * We are still waiting on the delivery of the DMA meters so they can be installed.
- * DC had their share of main repairs for June/July. We had 5 main repairs completed on Venus, Lakeland, Spinnaker, Pebble, and Anchor which included replacing 46' of pipe and a main valve. Anchor Village ended up having 2 different leaks on the main and one on the valve. In this section we also eliminated several other old repairs on this line.
 - * We only had 2 service lines replaced and 3 other repairs.

Sample stations sites/Boil water notices:

*We had to distribute out Boil Water for the shut downs in the areas for Venus, Lakeland, Anchor, Spinnaker and Pebble due to main repairs. The samples in these areas all came back absent for total Coliforms and E.Coli.

*DC crew is still collecting the routine BacT samples every Wednesday. All reports have come back absent for total Coliforms and E.Coli except for Cerrito, but we believe this was due to operator error. This area was in a boil water notice state due to the new temporary tanks install and tie in. The next two samples did come back absent.

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June / July 2022 Board letter

- ▶ June raw water NTU from the extended intake has been fairly stable mostly under 10. As we get into July the NTU levels are increasing but are staying under 20 so far. The ammonia levels are staying at low levels as well. Charge analyzer and jar testing are being done regularly; adjustments are being made and monitored. Filter backwashes continue to be every other day.
- ♦ Water production for the month of June 2022 was 20.236 MG. Raw water intake is 21.922 MG. Down from June 2021 production of 26.387 MG. Demands are rising as the temperatures increase
- We are still getting regular plant shut downs.
- Treatment has been able to do the weekly tank runs for testing of chlorine residuals in all the tank locations.
- Continuing maintenance / cleanup through the plant area.
- Filter 1 is back to operational status.
- ◆ The clarifier is back online, the tank farm has been drained, the tanks have begun being moved for other projects. Four of these are in place at Cerrito. T&S is working to get these setup for the redwood tank removal and replacement. Cerrito tank farm is now online.
- Guy Schott from SWRCB was out on 7-6-22 to do tracer study on the clearwell to determine contact time in the clearwell with aeration running and returning on 7-13-22, to run another without aeration.

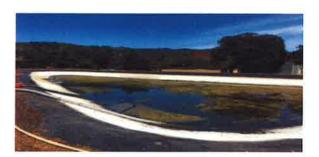

The month of June at the waste plant has been a very busy month. This is due mainly because of the dredging process as seen in the pictures below. During this process the supernatant is pumped out of the pond. Then we begin pumping sludge down the hill where it's received with a high dose of polymer for coagulation. After the injection process the thickened sludge is sent to our dewatering bags. This is done for Pond #1, #2 and the chlorine contact chamber. As noted in past reports the amount of sludge this year is huge. This reflects the amount of solids the waste plant took from the water plants operation.





After this dredge was completed we have gone back to having both stabilization ponds on line. This of course has brought up our Ph due to the detention time. There were a few occasions that our in house analysis results were above our permit discharge requirement. With some changes we have managed to control our Ph at this time. Worst case scenario would be going to one pond only. Other than the Ph the plant has run well. The additional aerator we installed in the oxidation ditch has not been required yet but it is ready for operation if needed. All maintenance and testing has been completed for the month as required.

Board Members.

2021-2022 fiscal year has officially ended and I'm excited to bring in 2022-2023. With the new emergency intake pump, water line repairs staff continue to fix, along with the eight million USDA water project continuing, I am in hopes that the water plant and our operators will have a much easier summer then they did last year.

2021-2022 Projected Budget:

Water income was at 125% with the expenses at 103%

Waste Water income was at 98% with the expenses at 92%

Once again, big thanks to the billing department for the hard work of filing for all the arears programs and reporting to the tax roll.

Water conservation remains at the top of the District's priority list and at last rough estimate, our water loss has went from approx. 50% down to the 20's. Keeping it in the 20's will be the challenge, however, until I can get a grant to replace the entire distribution system, this will be a never ending task.

With the completion of the clear well, T & S Construction has taken down the temporary tank farm at the Water Plant and have set the temporary tanks at Cerrito in preparation of replacing the old, leaky redwood tank. The Cerritos is now on the temporary tanks and the old tank is scheduled for demo next week.

I am giving my deposition to the US Attorney on the 19th, and hopefully will have a report for the Board by Thursdays' meeting.

The Clearlake Oaks Glen Haven Business Association dinner I was invited to speak at this month was postponed until August 25th due to a scheduling conflict with CPR training..

As always, a huge thank you to Staff for working hard and taking pride in a job well done.

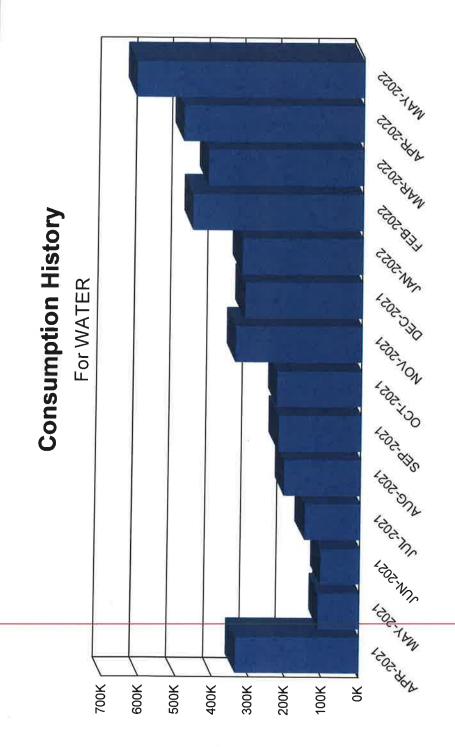
