- ∂ There are <u>14</u> accounts on payment arrangements.
 - We continue to receive payments from the LIHWAP program for past due balances, we are also referring customers to contact the program. To date, we have received \$8,236.00, this amount has prevented services from being shut off and has also restored services.
- The District continues to conduct its billing audit on vacant lots and unbilled properties within District boundaries. This will be an ongoing audit for an unknown period of time as I rely heavily on the DC and the rest of the Admin department for locating service connections.
- ∂ \ We are in the making progress getting the files prepared to send to Docufree. Admin is assisting with the location numbers on all of the APN files, I began last week sorting through Resolutions and Ordinances. All resolutions are sorted and ready to ship, finishing up Ordinances and Minutes will be thereafter.
- ∂ We purchased the CSDA Sample Policy Handbook at the conference in November, I have gone through about 80% of the recommended drafted policies, we will be implementing these within the Admin Code, stay tuned!!
- ∂ Badger was here on December 1st for a needed field visit, Bailey sat in on the almost full days' worth of work we had ahead of us as a training session for her. We accomplished everything that needed attention, and more. I'd say it was a very successful meeting.
 - Bailey is and has been being trained in the billing department, she is making great strides.
- As discussed, the proposed billable fee increases are on the agenda for approval this month, these have not been updated since 2015. Unfortunately, there are a handful of increases to be made, some higher percentages increases then others, and some increases that are still somewhat of a loss to the District.

- DC crew is still collecting the routine BacT samples every Wednesday. All reports have come back absent for total Coliforms and E.Coli.

November / December 2022 Board letter

- November raw water NTU from the extended intake has been fairly stable, primarily in the range of 8-10. November has been stable overall. The PH level has been dropping all month. The ammonia levels are staying at low levels as well. Charge analyzer and jar testing are being done regularly; adjustments are being made and monitored to keep up with PH changes. Filter backwashes continue to be every other day.
- Last month we were having an issue keeping the sludge blanket down, it is under better control, and however still not where we want it to be.
- ♦ Water production for the month of November 2022 was 15.477 MG. Raw water intake is 19.723 MG. Down from November 2021 production of 20.489 MG. Demands have been decreasing as the temperatures drop. The daily range we are producing less than last year is running about 150-200,000 gallons. Production has been averaging just below 500,000 GPD.
- We are still getting regular plant shut downs.
- ◆ Treatment has been able to do the weekly tank runs for testing of chlorine residuals in all the tank locations.
- Continuing maintenance / cleanup through the plant area.
- ♦ The Actiflo pilot trailer has been running with the plant since mid October we have been running one clarifier and the actiflo since then we have had some problems with sand, chemical doses and filter run time we have been able to overcome most of these problems, so far.
- An auto flush valve was installed on our Swan NTU meter that is hooked up the Actiflo. This was installed to stop alarm call outs for high turbidity due to flock build up in the meter and not true high turbidity, these call outs have since stopped.





◆ The check valve on our main high service pump failed allowing water from the distribution system to flow back into the clearwell and had to be replaced. The DC crew was extremely helpful in the replacement of this valve, thank you to all the DC crew for the help. The new valve also closes slower than the old one reducing water hammer

During the month of November the waste plant has continued to treat a good amount of solids coming from the water plant. The amount of waste activated sludge that is being produced is quite high. The process within the plant was not as affected this year due to the extra rotor we have installed in the oxidation ditch but the amount of solids that we have had to treat has been about the same. The additional treatment affects the cost at the waste plant in all phases. Treating solids at the water plant as the best approach has not been as transparent in the past. The drought has really exposed this reality. All we can do here at the waste plant is continue to process and continue to haul. On November we installed a temporary sump on the property as seen in the picture. This allows us to capture rain water coming from the levy road and the shops roof. Then it is pumped further onto the grounds so it can naturally flow. All this water was being directed to our bed with ended up in our ditch.



On the 10th we re-sampled for coliform on well #3. That has been submitted to Dean Enderlin for review. We are still waiting for the final report. Everything else is running fine. The process is within our WDR. Thanks for the attention.

3-2.104 METER REQUIRED

All meters, risers, service connections, and other equipment furnished by the District shall be placed, maintained, and repaired by the District. The customer shall provide a space for and exercise proper care to protect the property of the District. In the event of loss or damage to the District's property arising from neglect or misuse by the customer, the cost of necessary repairs or replacement shall be paid for by the customer.

3-5.106 RESTORATION OF WATER SERVICE

When service is terminated for failure to pay rates, fees, or charges, service shall not be restored to the former customer unless and until arrearages that resulted in the termination and costs incurred to terminate and restore service are paid to the District. Payment shall be by cash, credit or debit card, cashier's check, or money order. Payment processing through Doxo Pay does not qualify for restoration of service until funds have been received by District.

3-6.103 MISCELLANEOUS FEES

Payment processing through Doxo Pay does not qualify for restoration of service until funds have been received by District.

3-2.102 MISCELLANEOUS FEES

- (a) If the District takes steps to discontinue service for failure to comply with this Code, the customer shall pay the following additional charges before service is reinstated:
 - (1) A \$45.00 "Door Hanger Fee" for each trip to the property to deliver notice of disconnection of service.
 - (2) A \$50.00 "Turn on Fee" for each trip to the property during regular business hours at the request of the customer to reactivate sewer service previously disconnected for nonpayment.
 - (3) A \$175.00 "After Hours Service Fee" for each trip made to the property after regular business hours at the request of the customer.

Article 2- Maintenance and Inspection

The District follows a bi-annual maintenance schedule to inspect food service facilities, including visual inspection of any and all grease traps. If the District has cause to believe that a user is contributing to excessive grease build-up in the sewer system, either due to lack of appropriate grease control or maintenance, the District may order your interceptor to be cleaned within 30 days and a subsequent inspection to be performed. The user is responsible for costs incurred by the District to perform additional inspections, if it is determined that the District must re-inspect the interceptor, a \$145.00 fee will be associated with the re-inspection.
